Old: Business:

1. Ledger/Transcript bill for \$71.75 will come out of Supplies (4195-09)
2. Robblee tree will hold off cutting of North maple, until we have Winn Johnson, Certified Arborist do a Increment Bore sample of the large Maple, This will cost \$280, and we would like it done this week. MacStubbs will call Johnson and let him know that there is some urgency in this matter.
