The meeting was called to order at 4:00PM.

Minutes of 3/21/12 were read and approved.

Old Business;

A discussion of reprinting of maps. It was decided that we have what we need at the present time. Polly will call Bob Abbott and get his set of maps.

Treasurer's report for February was read and approved.

New Business;

The question arose about the NHCA meeting . Ethel will check on time and membership dues

A discussion about Perpetual Care and the Cemetery Maintenance Trust Fund. It was decided to seek guidance from Terry Knowles, or a person in that office. Ethel will set up a time for this meeting.

The time has come to do a pruning of the Liberty Elms, which will be done in late summer or early fall, when the Elm Beetles are dormant. It was suggested that we contact Scott Carbee to do this trimming.

A discussion of removal of the yucca plants from the Charles Bailey and also from another site. They are an impediment to mowing and leaf removal, and are spreading

A short discussion about the foliage around the Harwood stone. Ethel will try and speak to the person responsible about this and ask that it be cut back or removed.

At some point, we should check on reclaiming possible unused sites. This is time consuming, but could be beneficial to the use of the cemetery.

Ethel will talk to the Millers about the drainage ditch at the South end of the cemetery. A question of a French drain, covered with sand and then soil, would eliminate the collection of dead leaves.
