Minutes of previous meeting accepted as read.

Old Business:

- The maple tree in #3 between the middle and north sections needs to be removed. A tree fell in #2 outside of cemetery wall.
Polly will speak with Roblee about removing #3 tree and how best to address #2 tree.
- The water needs to be turned on.
Polly will contact the Millers.

It was decided we will let the water line issue rest and address problems as they occur.

New Business:

- Discussion of what we want done in #3 using the budget line Landscaping Maintenance, hiring Bob Abbott:
 - 1) pruning shrubs middle, left, front
 - 2) shrub removed from middle, right, beside the lane going toward So section
 - 3) ask Bob for suggestion of seeding with fertilizer
Polly will talk with Bob.
- The responsibility of grass seeding is ours, or Grounds Keeping at \$38./hr
- Charlie Lord was buried in a full casket 4/4. Wife Patricia will have her ashes placed on top of her husband's casket when she passes.
- Georgie Thomas, Jack's 2nd wife, is coming at the end of the month to purchase two casket lots.
- Ethel will maintain a record of purchase of lots and burials.
- We will approach the new folks at Crams Inn regarding the mowing of the strip on No side after a period of time. They moved in May 1st.
- Kaufman put in Pellitier's corner markers, looked at the Putnam monument and small stone, all in #3. He will make an appointment in the future to tour #2 looking at needed repairs.
- Polly will look into purchasing 60 steel pegs to place beside the cemetery row markers in No and So sections to facilitate finding the markers when they become buried.
