New Business

- 1) We amend our Schedule of Lot Fees to read: "At the time of purchase of lot, a check will be made out to Peterborough Marble and Granite Works for purchase and installation of corner markers. The costs are \$125.00 for 4 plain markers and \$195 for 4 initialed markers."

This will facilitate establishing boundaries soon after purchase and keep the transaction clear of our bookkeeping.

- 2) We have been asked to send a copy of the burials in Sleeper Cemetery to a descendant and Polly will do that.
- 3) Jack and Nancy Curran have inquired about available room in the Bixby plot for burials. Upon investigation there are multiple Bixby lots with no recorded burials and two vacancies in the T.E. Bixby (the 1st) which would need to be approved by any one of the generation above Jack. All of this will be thoroughly clarified after Polly speaks with the Currans.
- 4) The Millers have been alerted to the water problems in #3. Ethel will contact Rick to see what they found.

There have been four burials and the sale of two cremation lots this year.
