11/2/2015 – 11/8/2015

1. On 11/2 at 0800 received a call from a citizen complaining of speeding vehicle along New Boston Road and Potash Road. Complainant was contacted. The Fracestown Police Department will be conducting “directed patrols” in this area in order to increase the safety of the pedestrians and motoring public in general.
2. On 11/3 at 0827 received a call for an E-911 hang up call on Dodge Hill Road. Upon arrival it was determined that this was a false alarm. Cleared.
3. On 11/5 at 1302 received a call for a motor vehicle complaint that occurred on Candlewood Hill Road. It was reported that a suspect vehicle had failed to exercise caution when meeting two horses that were being ridden along the roadway. During the investigation the operator of the vehicle was located. The operator was advised of requirements under RSA 265:104 Approaching Horses. Complainant notified of finding. Cleared.
4. On 11/5 at 0116 received a call from the Connecticut State Police requesting a death notification be made in this town. State Police made notification.
