8/3/2015 – 8/9//2015

1. On 8/3 @ 0630 a citizen found a canine in the area of Pleasant Pond Road and transported it to the police station. The canine's owner was located on Old County Road South and was returned. Cleared
2. On 8/3 @ 1436 responded to the area of Old County Road North for a report that a school bus was disabled. Upon arrival located vehicle with no driver around. Vehicle not a hazard to motoring public and wrecker was in route. Cleared.
3. On 8/3 @ 1730 responded to Perley Road for a report criminal mischief/conduct after an accident complaint. Upon arrival the reporting party stated that between the hours of 1:00pm and 4:30 PM an unknown driver operating a dual wheel vehicle severely damaged the complainants stonewall and left the scene without contacting the owners. The investigation confirmed determined that the vehicle in question had dual rear wheels. Certain evidence was obtained at the scene and the investigation will continue.
