## Press Release

9/28/2015 – 10/20/2015

1. On 9/28 at 0834 received a complaint of criminal mischief in the area of 419 Dodge Hill Road. Complainant reported that there was damage done to his lawn area. Investigation is continuing.
2. On 9/28 at 1036 received a report of a brush fire which was still smoldering at 400 Woodward Hill Road. Keene Mutual Aid advised.
3. On 9/28 at 1334 received a complaint of drug activity on King Hill Road. Complainant requested assistance from Fracestown Police. Upon arrival at location all parties were spoken with and during the investigation there were several illegal items seized by this agency. Investigation continuing.
