2/8/2016 – 2/14/2016

1. On 2/8 at 2110 received a report of disabled motor vehicle identified as a tractor trailer unit on Bennington Road. The snow covered road conditions attributed to the vehicle not being able to proceed northbound along Bennington Road. Operator was able to proceed at later time.
2. On 2/9 at 1335 received a report of snow being pushed across and left in roadway on South New Boston Road. Responded to the scene and spoke with person responsible. Operator was issued final warning for violation of town ordinance. Cleared.
3. On 2/9 at 2105 received a report of a possible impaired driver leaving the Crotched Mountain Ski area and heading southbound on Route 47 into Fracestown. Fracestown Police immediately checked Route 47 to the Bennington town line with no contact. All surrounding towns were given the description of suspect vehicle. Cleared.
4. On 2/10 at 1355 received a report for a medical emergency on Pleasant Pond Road for elderly male experiencing difficulty breathing. Upon arrival assisted medical services with the victim and then cleared without further incident.
5. On 2/10 at 1410 located a vehicle off the roadway on the 2nd New Hampshire Turnpike (south) near Russell Station Road. Fracestown Police assisted the operator until the wrecker arrived and cleared without further incident.
6. On 2/10 at 2311 received a report of a fire alarm activation at a residence located on Scoby Road. Fracestown Fire Department responded and provided service.
7. On 2/12 at 1845 received a report of a vehicle operating erratically headed northbound from the center of town towards Crotched Mountain. Upon arrival in the area the suspect vehicle was not located. Cleared.
