## **Press Release**

**3/14/2016 – 3/27/2016**

1. On 3/14 at 1033 received a call for an abandoned vehicle located on the cell tower Road off East Road. Upon investigation the vehicle was located and determined that the vehicle was off the access road and abandoned for several days. Vehicle owner could not be located and was towed. Owner contacted department at later time was advised where the vehicle was towed.
2. On 3/14 at 1331 responded to a report of a vehicle off the road, no injuries in the area of Greenfield Road and Birdsall Road. Upon arrival assisted wrecker operator with traffic while vehicle was removed. Cleared without further incident.
3. On 3/17 at 0900 responded to past tense report of a vicious dog complaint in the area of Torey Pine Condominiums. Investigation completed and both canine owners advised that no court action was warranted.
4. On 3/17 at 1602 report of a road hazard / tree down on electrical wires in area of 211 Bible Hill Road. Fracestown Fire Department responded and road was closed.
5. On 3/18 at 1030 report of tree on electrical wires in the area of 358 Dodge Hill Road. Eversource Power Company advised. Cleared without further incident.

Investigation into the matter was initiated. The juvenile was located in Francestown and was taken into temporary custody without incident. The juvenile was released to the Peterborough Police Department in the town of Greenfield.

On 3/22 at 0842 the Francestown police Department received a call from the Conval High School Administration requesting this agency conduct a welfare check at a residence located on Pleasant Pond Road. Francestown Police Department responded and affirmed the request of the welfare check and cleared without further incident.

Francestown PD is following up on this information with the New Hampshire Fish and Game Department. Investigation continuing.

15. On 3/26 @ 1321 received a report from a complainant from Dodge Hill Road of the discharging of a firearm in the area of Scoby Pond. Investigation is continuing into the matter.
