4/11/2016 – 4/19/2016

1. On 4/11 at 1530 received a report to respond to a neighbor dispute On Marino Road. Upon arrival the investigation was initiated which is still pending. The investigation is continuing. Cleared without further incident.
2. On 4/11 at 1630 received a report of a vehicle speeding along Poor Farm Road. The investigation identified the operator and the complainant reported that this was an on-going issue with the driver. Further investigation being initiated with the accused to resolve issue.
3. On 4/12 at 1510 responded to a residence on Oak Hill Road for a report of a stray canine. Canine was located and returned to their owner on Muzzey Road. Cleared without further incident.
4. On 4/13 at 1218 received a 911-hang up in the area of Second NH Turnpike. No one located at the residence, cleared without further incident.
5. On 4/11 at 2111 received a report of a motor vehicle collision involving one vehicle in area of 45 New Boston Road and Route 136. State police advised along with Keene Mutual Aid dispatch.
