5/23/2016 – 6/5/2016

1. On 5/27 at 1543 received a call for mutual aid in assisting the Milford Police Department for a conduct after accident that occurred in Milford. The suspect and vehicle was alleged to have struck and damaged a vehicle in Milford and left the scene without reporting the damage. The suspect was reportedly from Fracestown and the vehicle was a 2001 Jeep Wrangler registered to a resident. The Fracestown Police Department located the vehicle and the registered owner. Upon further investigation there was evidence established that this vehicle and the owner were involved and an investigation report was forwarded to the Milford Police Department. An arrest warrant is pending.
2. On 5/29 at 2151 received a complaint of a motor vehicle on 2nd New Hampshire Turnpike headed westbound following to close. State Police advised of complaint.
3. On 5/30 at 1928 received a complaint of OHRV's at the end of Dennison Pond Road operating illegally on the class 6 portion. Investigation on-going.
4. On 5/31 at 0952 received a report of an alarm activation on 2nd New Hampshire Turnpike (north). Upon arrival the activation was false. Cleared.
5. On 5/31 at 1039 received a call from a resident of a possible scam by receiving repeated telephone calls from an alleged IRS. The reporting person was advised on the proper way to handle this issue.
6. On 5/31 at 2127 received a report of a single motor vehicle collision involving a deer on New Boston Road and Scoby Road. The operator who was a resident of Fracestown was not injured and the deer had expired. New Hampshire State accident report completed.
7. On 6/1 at 2016 received a report of a medical emergency in the area of Dennison Pond Road for a young male from Weare that had a mountain bike accident with a possible head injury. Emergency Services responded and the victim's parent was notified.

8. On 6/3 at 1435 received a call for a medical emergency on Trailside Lane for a foot injury. Emergency Services responded.
9. On 6/4 at 0924 received a report of a medical emergency in the area New Boston Road for 45 year old female difficulty breathing. Emergency Services responded.
10. On 6/4 at 1326 received a report of a single motor vehicle collision/rollover in the area of Bennington Road and School-House Road. Under Mutual Aid, Bennington PD and State Police responded to the scene of the collision.
