Press Release

6/13/2016 – 6/27/2016

1. On 6/13 at 1159 received a report of a theft in the area of Bennington Road. Upon investigation it was reported by the complainant that during the night time hours on 6/12 at 1100 and 6/13 at 0700 his lawn mower was removed from his storage area. Information was also received that the same type of lawn mower was observed on the edge of the roadway on Bennington Road, however was removed between the hours of 0700 and approximately 1100 on 6/13. The investigation into this theft is continuing.
2. On 6/13 at 0930 received a report of a stolen vehicle in the area of Bennington Road. It was report that a 2000 Jeep Cherokee was removed from a driveway without the owner's authorization and that the keys were left in the vehicle at the time of the theft. The NH State Police responded to take the initial report. The stolen vehicle was located a short time later in the town of Antrim after a report of a suspicious vehicle was reported by a citizen. The matter remains under investigation by the New Hampshire State Police.
3. On 6/14 at 1236 received a report of a single motor vehicle collision on New Boston Road (Route 136) with personal injury and entrapment. Upon emergency services arrival it was determined that the operator was the only occupant at the time of the collision. The operator was identified as one Scott K. Martin age 21 of Greenfield, New Hampshire. The operator was extricated from the vehicle by emergency services and transported to a hospital and air-lifted. The investigation indicated that the operator was operating a 2000 Jeep Wrangler eastbound when the vehicle transitioned off on the southern portion of the roadway and impacting a large tree. The investigation is continuing and the operator may be subject to prosecution.
4. On 6/14 at 1235 received a report of alarm activation on the 2nd NH Turnpike and it was determined to be false.
5. On 6/15 at 0621 received a report of alarm activation in the Wilson Hill Road area. This was cancelled within a short time of the activation.
6. On 6/15 at 0633 received a report of alarm activation in the area of the 2nd NH Turnpike (North). State Police handled the response.
7. On 6/17 at 1538 received a report of a medical emergency for a 77 year old female feeling ill. Emergency services responded and assisted the victim.

8. On 6/17 at 2336 received a report of a motor vehicle collision involving a vehicle and a deer. The operator stated that there were no injuries or damage to the vehicle and that that the deer ran off into the woods. Operator given information on how to proceed.
9. On 6/18 at 2049 received a report of a possible stolen vehicle on the complainant's property in the area of Pleasant Pond Road. State Police investigating the complaint.
10. On 6/19 at 1620 received a report of a damaged bridge plank on Russell Station Road. The Francestown Road Agent was contacted and resolved the issue.
11. On 6/20 at 1052 received a report of a vehicle that was reportedly left in town in an unknown location. Operator was home and parents requested assistance in locating the vehicle. In coordination with the Francestown Highway Department the vehicle was located on Muzzey Road by the Highway employee. Cleared.
12. On 6/21 at 0442 received a report of wires down and a small fire which was now out in the area of New Boston Road. Emergency services responded.
13. On 6/21 at 1116 received a complaint from a citizen located on Oak Hill Road of harassment and criminal trespass complaint. During the investigation the suspect had been identified. The investigation is continuing that criminal charges are forthcoming.
14. On 6/21 at 1953 received a report of a well-being check of a young female child in the area of Main Street. State Police was given the call for service and this agency is continuing the investigation into the matter.
15. On 6/22 at 1659 received a report of a suspicious vehicle in the area of Old County Road (North). Initial investigation indicated that the vehicle and the occupant was reported being reported as missing on 6/15 out of Wilton, New Hampshire. It was determined that the vehicle was actually on Homestead Road in Deering. The Deering Police Department was contacted by this agency and given all the pertinent information of the vehicle.
16. On 6/22 at 2136 received a report of erratic operation of two vehicles in the area of Greenfield Road. State Police forwarded the call.
17. On 6/23 at 1608 received a report of a motor vehicle collision involving a deer in the area of Udall Road. Investigation indicated that the deer ran into wooded area and there was minor damage to the vehicle which was driven away by the operator.
18. On 6/24 at 1020 received a report of alarm activation in the area of Scoby Road. It was determined that it was accidental Cleared.
19. On 6/25 at 1014 received a report of alarm activation in the area of Wilson Hill Road. Alarm response cancelled prior to arrival at scene.
20. On 6/25 at 1029 received a report of alarm activation on the area of South New Boston Road.
