6/27/2016 – 7/10/2016

1. On 6/28 at 1550 hours received a report of a vehicle striking a stop sign at the intersection of Oak Hill Road and Main Street. Description of the vehicle was given and the vehicle was stopped on New Boston Road. The operator's information was obtained and the State Department of Transportation notified of the damage. Investigation report provided.
2. On 6/29 at 1928 hours received a report of a prior burglary in the Candlewood Road area. Victim indicated that forced entry was made but nothing appeared missing. State Police are conducting the investigation.
