6/6/2016 – 6/13/2016

1. On 6/6 at 8:20am received a report for a medical emergency in the area of Birdsall Road for an 81 year old male feeling ill. Emergency Services responded and assisted with patient.
2. On 6/7 at 8:18am received a report for a medical emergency in the area of Main Street for an 84 year old male with severe pain. Emergency Services responded and assisted the patient.
3. On 6/7 at 6:47pm received a report for a disabled motor vehicle in the Russell Station Road area. Vehicle was checked and remained there over night. Cleared.
4. On 6/9 at 1:35pm a Richard A. GILL, age 54 of 29 East Road Apt. # 10 was arrested on an active arrest warrant issued out of the 9th Circuit-District Division Court-Milford NH. The subject was taken into custody and charged with Conduct After an Accident (Class A Misdemeanor) and Operating After Suspension/Revocation (violation). The defendant was bailed and released on \$2,500.00 PR and will appear in the 9th Circuit Court in Milford on July 13, 2016 at 8:30am.
5. On 6/9 at 1:50pm received a report of a motor vehicle collision on Main Street involving a tractor trailer unit and a tree that had come upon it. Greenfield Police Department responded to the location and determined that no damage was caused. Francestown Highway employee responded and assisted in the removal of a large tree limb that was found between the tractor trailer cab and the trailer which also blocked both lanes of traffic. No injuries reported.
6. On 6/9 at 2:28pm received a report of a road hazard where a tree had come down across south New Boston Road. Upon arrival a neighbor and the responding officer were removing the obstruction and the Francestown Highway employees arrived at the scene and completed the removal process. Cleared.
