1. On 8/16 at 1146 hours received a report of residential alarm activation in the New Boston Road area. Upon arrival it was determined that it was accidental. Cleared scene.
2. On 8/17 at 0054 hours received a report of a medical emergency on Eastside Lane. Emergency Services responded and assisted the victim.
3. On 8/17 at 1039 hours received a report to respond to Second NH Turnpike North for a report of a theft that had occurred. Upon arrival and further investigation over the next several days it was determined that the items alleged to have been stolen were removed with authorization. Investigation closed.
4. On 8/17 at 1243 hours received a report of a suspicious motor vehicles parked in a driveway in the King Hill Road area. Upon arrival and further investigation it was determined that the Out of State vehicle was visiting the owners of the residence.
5. On 8/18 at 1851 hours received a report of a vicious canine in the area of Muzzey Road where the complainant was chased by the canine. Investigation is continuing into this matter to identify the canine's owner.
6. On 8/20 at 1059 hours received alarm activation in the Main Street area. Upon arrival it was determined to be accidental. Cleared.
7. On 8/21 at 0942 hours received a report of criminal mischief in the area of Farrington Road and the Crotched Mountain Town Forest. Complainant reported that bike race signage had been removed, destroyed and thrown on the ground in the area. Upon investigation it was determined that an unknown autistic male who was missing from Crotched Mountain Rehilabation Center was in the area. The male was located in a semi-remote area near the bike race route. The staff at the Crotched Mountain Rehilabation Center was contacted to take custody of the young male and asked to clean and pickup the area that had been littered. Cleared scene.
